Definitions	2	Hours of Darkness - Means the period from 30 minutes after sunset to 30 minutes before sunrise, or at any time when, because of insufficient light or unfavourable atmospheric conditions, persons or vehicles cannot be seen at a distance of 150 meters.	This clarifies the requirement for lighting and also hours of darkness inspections	April 21, 2020
5.3	12	Contrary to the Geometric Design Guide, illumination is a requirement for onsite detours.	Currently the Geometric Design Guides indicates that "Generally" illumination is required. This will reinforce the requirement for illumination for onsite detours.	April 21, 2020
5.6	12	Flagperson Ahead signs (WD-A-21) should not exceed 1.5km in advance of the flagperson	Provides additional warning of the upcoming flagperson	April 21, 2020
5.7	14	Where a site specific investigation indicates a high probability of continuing accidents, or such occurrences are indicated by accident history, the Consultant or AT may require clear zone distances greater than the 9 meters as indicated.
